Retention Rates

- Defined as the percentage of bachelors-seeking students who return from one fall term to the next.
- The 2023 national average retention rate is <u>68%</u>.¹

Post-graduation/Career outcomes

Each year the IWU Life Calling and Career office conducts a survey of all bachelor's degree graduates called the First Destination Survey (FDS). These items are key metrics taken from the FDS annual report.

- Total Career Outcomes (Placement) Rate = 93%
- Excellence Rate = 90%
- Continuing Education Rate = 18%
- Average annual salary = \$49,207
