

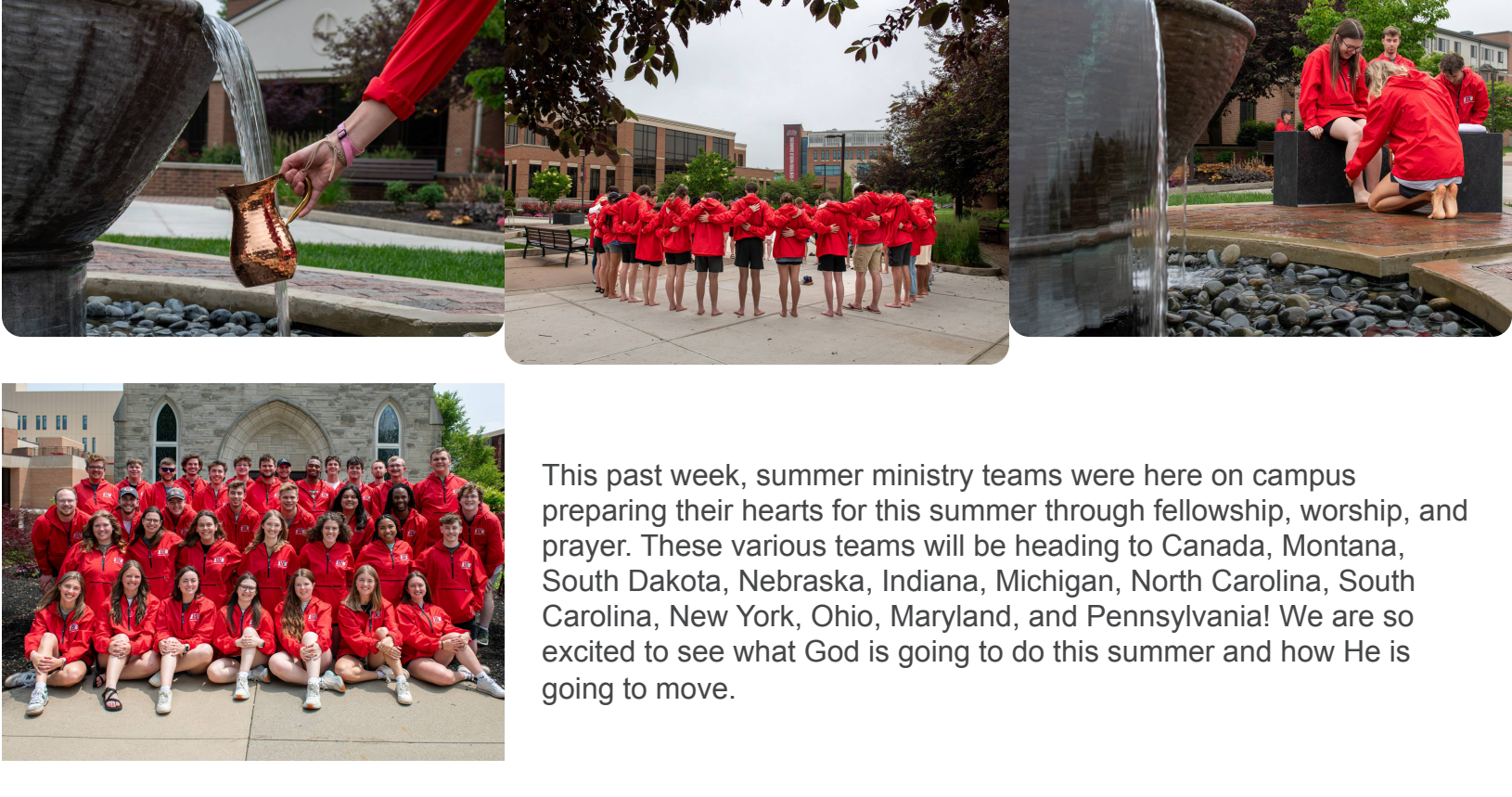

IWU Summer Ministry Teams 2025

#3 Ranking in NAIA LEARFIELD Directors' Cup

For the seventh-straight year, Indiana Wesleyan University earned a Top 5 finish in the final standings of the NAIA LEARFIELD Directors' Cup. This prestigious award was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and USA Today. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in the NAIA National Championships. The Wildcats totaled 889.25 points for a third place in the standings. The University of the Cumberlands (Ky.) took home the title for the second year in a row with 1,014 points, while Keiser University was runner-up with 954 points. IWU was joined by four other Crossroads League schools in the Top 50.

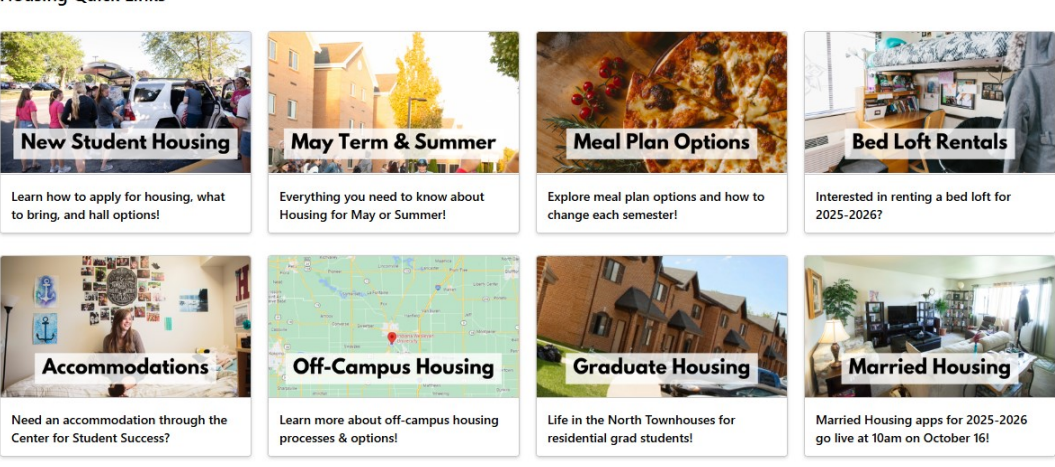

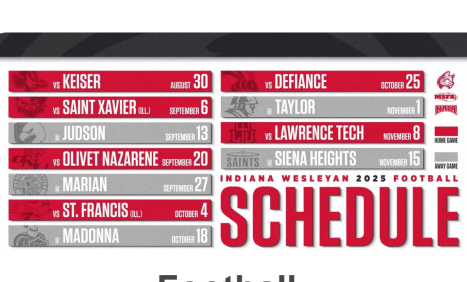

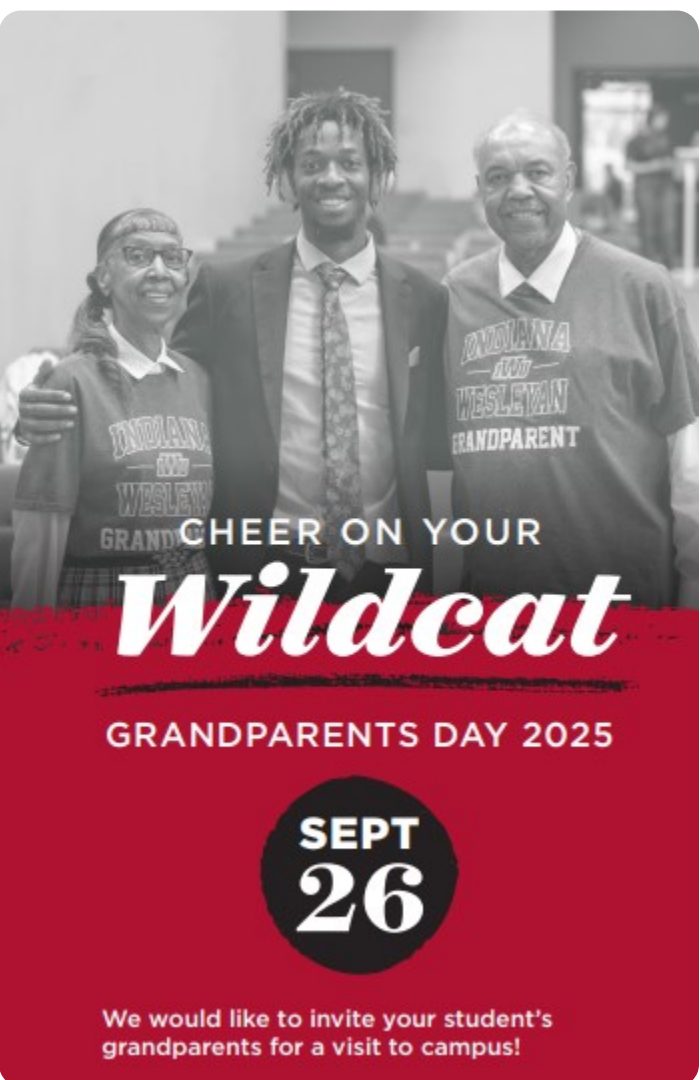
Grandparents Day
