An official evaluation of JST, CCAF transcripts, and all other prior college-level learning will be completed upon application to IWU. Students may request an unofficial evaluation of their JST or CCAF transcripts prior to applying, so that they have a clear understanding of how their military credits will transfer to IWU.

A minimum of 30 semester credit hours within the major must be successfully completed at IWU for the award of an IWU Bachelor of Science degree.

A total of **120 semester credit hours** are required to graduate with a Bachelor of Science degree at IWU. Electives required to reach 120 credits may come from military training, previous college-level education, credit through testing, or taken at IWU.
